SPEECH OF THE SECRETARY TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATION (SGF) AT THE OFFICAL LUNCH OF NIGERIA AIDS INDICATOR AND IMPACT SURVEY (NAIIS), AT THE ASO ROCK PRESIDENTIAL VILLA, ON THURSDAY 28TH JUNE 2018

Today is another historic day in the annals of the administration of President Mohammadu Buhari and Nigeria as a country, as we are here gathered for the launching of Nigeria AIDS Indicator and Impact Survey (NAIIS)- which has been termed the largest HIV/AIDS survey in the world!

Nigeria has made progress over the years in generating quality data that robustly inform policy, planning. and implementation of evidence-based measures in our unwavering pursuit to control and end the HIV epidemic in our country. On behalf of the Federal Government of Nigeria, I wish to sincerely thank the United States Government, which through the US CDC has been providing enormous financial, technical and human resources to support the Nigeria AIDS Indicator and Impact Survey. The financial support of the Global Fund to this survey is equally greatly appreciated.

Furthermore, the Federal Government appreciates the hard work of the Surveys Steering Committee, ably chaired by the Honourable Minister of Health, Prof. Isaac Adewole, and the DG NACA, Dr. Sani Aliyu, for providing incredible leadership. We are also deeply grateful to the survey Technical Committee and the Project Implementation Team (PIT) that have been working tirelessly to provide technical guidance to the University of Maryland, Baltimore, (UMB) consortium of Implementing Partners.

Similarly, we acknowledge the warm cooperation and buy-in of all the State Governors in Nigeria, their Commissioners for Health and Executive Secretaries/Project Managers of State Agencies for the Control of AIDS (SACAs) towards the successful conduct of this very important survey in their States.
