The Independent Corrupt Practices and Other Related Offenses Commission (ICPC) in collaboration with the Office of the Secretary to the Government of the Federation (OSGF) is organizing the 4th edition of the Annual National Summit on Diminishing Corruption in the Public Sector/ 2022 Public Sector Integrity Award.
