Entrance Examination for Admission into the Federal Treasury Academy (FTA) Diploma Programme in Public Financial Management (PFM)

The Federal Treasury Academy, (FTA) Orozo wishes to inform all Accountants/Auditors in the services of the Federal, States, and Local Governments that the Academy will conduct entrance examination for its Diploma Course in Public Financial Management for 2019/2020 Academic session as follows:

2.0 Entrance Examination

The entrance examination for the programme will take the form of a one hour, 50 multiple choice question paper in Basic Mathematics, English, Commerce and Accounting designed to test candidates' skills in numeracy, literacy and related areas necessary to ensure that they will be able to cope with the demands of the programme.

2.1 Entrance examination for the selection of qualified candidates into the Programme will be conducted as follows:

- 2.2 Eligible candidates will be issued with entrance examination slips from the Office of the Registrar, Federal Treasury Academy, Orozo.
- 3.0 The FTA Diploma in Public Sector Accounting and Finance
 This is a two year Full time programme leading to the award of the Federal
 Treasury Academy Diploma in Public Financial Management.

3.1 Eligibility for Admission

Interested candidates for this course are required to possess any of the following qualifications:

i. National Diploma (ND) in Accounting/Business Administration or related courses; WASC/NECO/GCE O' Level or its equivalent with credit in 5 subjects; including English Language and Mathematics.

ii. Officers not below GL.06 and possess the Accounting Technician Certificate of ICAN/ANAN are also eligible to apply.

3.2 Other Requirements

Prospective Candidates are to note that:

- i. All qualifications must have been obtained from approved institutions of learning and computer literate candidates will have added advantage.
- ii. Certificates submitted will be scrutinized/ verified and holders of fake certificates will be disqualified and reported to appropriate authorities.
- iii. Photocopies of certificates of all educational and professional qualifications of candidates should be attached.
- iv. Gazette publications or copies of letters of first appointment, confirmation and last promotion should be attached.
- v. The programme is a full time programme with **70%** mandatory class attendance.

3.3 Commencement

The programme will commence effectively in the Federal Treasury Academy, Orozo - Abuja, on Monday, 14th October 1, 2019.

4.0 Sponsorship
